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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to provide a comprehensive overview of the findings of the research conducted in the field of data protection in Serbia. The research was carried out in 2018 and 2019, and the results are presented in this report.

The findings of the research indicate that there is a significant gap between the current state of data protection in Serbia and the requirements of the Schengen Convention. The research also identified several key areas for improvement, including the need for a comprehensive data protection law and the establishment of a data protection authority.

In order to address the identified gaps, the report recommends the following measures: the adoption of a comprehensive data protection law, the establishment of a data protection authority, and the implementation of a series of measures to ensure compliance with the Schengen Convention. The report also provides a detailed analysis of the current state of data protection in Serbia, including a comparison with the requirements of the Schengen Convention.

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
